Residential does not have an application fee.

If your check is returned by your banking institution, your application will be withheld from further processing until full payments is properly made. Including reimbursement for any returned check charges.

Information Needed to Complete the Application Process

As an applicant for the apprenticeship program, I understand that it is my responsibility to provide all the following information. I further acknowledge that I must submit all required information to the JATC within the time frame provided below. Therefore, I am responsible to see that all documents are received by the JATC.

When First Applying:

Completed Apprenticeship Application Request Form

DD214 if you have been Honorably discharged from the Military within the last 5 years. If you are still active duty in the military you will need a memo from your current commanding officer stating you name, estimated departure date & under what conditions (Honorable, General).

Veteran's Honorably discharged from the Military within the last 5 years receive the below accommodations:

- Waiver of application fee
- Must still take aptitude test but is used for counseling purposes only.
- Guaranteed an interview.

After submitting Apprenticeship Application Request form:

You will have **10 days** to return the actual application to the JATC.

You will have **60 days** to return the required documents to complete the application.

- Provide documentation of being a high school graduate or have a GED (with score sheet) or having a two-year Associate Degree or higher.
- Provide an **OFFICIAL** transcript from high school and post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
- Proved evidence of successful completion of one full year of high school algebra with a C or better, or one post high school algebra course with a passing grade if not already provided on **Official** High School transcripts submitted.
- If you have prior electrical experience & your hours are on file with L&I a "print screen of hours" from L&I will need to be provided.

PLEASE NOTE

To qualify for an oral interview, an applicant must obtain a score of "5" or higher (Inside), "4" or higher (Low Voltage), using the electrical trade's aptitude test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research. Residential applicants do not take the aptitude test.

Applicants are not scheduled for the above mention aptitude test until all required documents have been submitted to the JATC. Completed application, submitted official documentation showing proof of graduation and meeting the algebra requirement.

Applicants who qualify for an oral interview are interviewed in the order in which they complete the application process.

Apprenticeship Program Participation

As an apprentice in this apprenticeship and training program you may be required to report for on-the-job training assignments anywhere within the employment jurisdiction of the JATC. The geographic jurisdiction, by county, of this JATC is as follows:
